### **TOURNAMENT TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

- 1. **Team Entries.** Each District affiliated to Bowls South Africa is invited to enter individual teams of four only one travelling reserves per District. Districts may submit as many team entries as required with the understanding that the entries for their B, C, etc. teams can only be confirmed after the closing date. If more than one team is entered the entry form must clearly indicate whether it is the A, B, C, etc. team and cannot be changed once the draw has been done.
- 2. Player Eligibility. All players, both male and female, who may turn 25 years of age during the year of the event (i.e. players must have been born in or after 1999). Players must however be over the age of 18 at the commencement of the event.
- 3. **Bowls SA Membership Data Base.** The Players' <u>Bowls SA Membership numbers</u> must be included on the entry form.
- 4. **Mixed Teams.** Any single gender or combination of male and female players may be used for the composition of a team of four players.
- 5. **Players on Loan:** Districts may '**loan**' players from other Districts. Refer to Bowls SA Circular 54/2010.
- 6. **Team Managers.** Teams must be accompanied by a Manager. A **maximum of 2** Managers per District will, irrespective of the number of entries accepted, be allowed. The Manager is the guardian of the players during the tournament and must ensure that good control over their players is always exercised. The Manager must therefore ensure that the players are always under the care of the Manager. All appointed Team Managers **must** be in possession of a valid **SA Police Services / Postnet Clearance Certificate**. The Manager must have his/her SAPS Clearance Certificate at the tournament and make it available upon request.
- 7. **Indemnity and Consent Forms.** Managers to keep completed indemnity and consent forms, of all players under the age of 18 years, handy at tournament.
- 8. **Conditions of Entry.** The District and Manager must agree to the conditions of entry as set out on the entry form.
- 9. **Meals.** Lunches and teas will be provided free of charge for all players, reserves and the registered managers during the tournament. Districts will be required to make their own arrangements regarding breakfasts and suppers.

- 11. **Accommodation and Transport.** Please note that all arrangements regarding accommodation and transport will be the responsibility of each District.
- 12. **Financial Support.** We are pleased to advise that a grant as stipulated below will be paid into the District's account, will accrue to the District for **each entry (team) accepted**.
  - Southern Free State R1 000 per team
  - Northern Free State and Northern Cape R1 500 per team
  - Sables, Sedibeng, JBA, BGN, EKB and NWB R2 500 per team
  - KZNCB, Kingfisher, NIBA, PNB and MP R3 000 per team
  - Border, EPB, Eden, WPB, Boland and Limpopo R3 500 per team
- 13. **Bowls SA Participation Certificates** will be made out strictly as per the names appearing on the **declaration form**. Any name changes or spelling mistakes after the final declaration of teams will be for the account of the District.
- 14. **Alcohol. Players** and/or **Manager** may not consume alcohol outside of the Bowling Club's Clubhouse and/or bar facility, whilst play (by any team(s)) is still in progress.
- 15. **Smoking.** Players and/or Managers may not smoke in the vicinity of the greens.
- 16. **SAIDS and Doping Procedures.** The District and Manager are to ensure that they understand and comply with the relevant policy and/or Bowls SA circulars.
- 17. **POPI Act.** All participants agree to allow Bowls SA, and any of its agents/affiliates, to take photos and/or videos of them and use such for promotional activities. All participants also agree to allow Bowls SA to live stream games/interviews in which the players participate. In exceptional cases and upon special notice, by means of a letter, participants may request exemption from this clause.
